LUCA POMPILIO

Italian pianist Luca Pompilio has performed across Europe and the Americas. He holds Bachelor's degrees in physics and in music (Pavia, Italy); a diploma in chamber music with an emphasis on flute and piano repertoire (Florence, Italy); and an MM in piano performance from SHSU (Texas), where he was also a teaching assistant. He is currently a DMA student and TA at University of Colorado Boulder, under the guidance of David Korevaar.

Luca is a dedicated performer, researcher and educator. Highlights of 2025 include being a solo piano fellow at "Aspen Music Festival", and his South American debut as a soloist with Orquestra Sinfonica de Goiania (Brazil). In previous years, he performed at "Art of the Piano 2024" at San Francisco Conservatory of Music, Sion Festival and Academy in Switzerland, Avila International Music Festival 2023 in Spain. He has played in masterclasses and lessons with world-famous pianists such as Jeremy Denk, Alexander Korsantia, Hie Yon Choi, Spencer Mayer, Anton Nel, Michel Beroff, Roberto Paruzzo, Diego Caetano, etc.

Luca has been researching piano works by Italian composers, with a focus on the music of Mario Castelnuovo-Tedesco, presenting a lecture-recital at La frontera International Piano Conference 2025 (UTRGV, Texas). As an educator, he has experience teaching masterclasses, individual students of all ages and levels, group classes in university, etc.
